

2015 Charter Review Commission

The Kyle City Council appointed a Charter Review Commission to review the City's existing charter and make recommendations about possible changes to the Charter in February 2015. Recommendations were made based on the review and discussion by the commission and included input from the public. The Council considered the Charter Review Commission's recommendations, and there is a Special Election scheduled for May 7, 2016 for the proposed Charter Amendments.
