This model balances the elected authority of the Mayor and City Council with the expertise and professional management provided by a City Manager.



The City Manager's primary role is to implement the decisions made by the City Council and to manage the day-to-day operations of the City.

Responsibilities of the City Manager


The City Manager plays a pivotal role in Kyle's local government, carrying out a variety of essential duties:




